Activities in May 2021 - July 2022

This report covers the activities done to set up the group Women in Fusion, its foundation and main goals.

Summary of the FEC 2020 webinar - initial activity

A webinar on Women in Fusion took place as side event at the FEC 2020 on 12nd May 2021 (<u>Women in Fusion (FEC 2020) - YouTube</u>) organised by IAEA. Around 100 people connected in live and up to now more than 2.000 people have watched in YouTube.

It was highlighted that the Q&A session at the webinar was of particular interest because the questions raised reflected many of the standing issues.

The proposal of making this WiF side even part of the FEC series, to take place every Wednesday of the week of the conference a lunch time will be taken to the IFRC for formal approval.

The main conclusion of this webinar was that a global group of Women in Fusion should be created.

Follow up activities after the webinar

A follow-up meeting of the FEC 2020 webinar took place remotely 14-15 October 2021 and it was decided to start to work on the set up of the Women in Fusion group. Goals and working plan for the next months were defined.

In subsequent meetings the objectives as well as the logo and motto were produced.
