## 1. Cookies

The user consents to and authorizes the use of cookies.

This website uses Google Analytics, a web analytics service provided by Google, Inc., a Delaware company with its main office at 1600 Amphitheatre Parkway, Mountain View (California), CA 94043, United States ("Google"). Google Analytics uses "cookies", which are text files placed on your computer, to help the website analyze how users use the site. The information generated by the cookie about your use of the website will be transmitted to and stored by Google on servers in the United States. Google will use this information on our behalf for the purpose of tracking your use of the website, compiling reports on website activity, and providing other services related to website activity and internet usage. Google may also transfer this information to third parties when required by law or when such third parties process the information on Google's behalf. Types, Purpose, and Functioning of Cookies on Womeninfusion.org

Cookies can be classified by their duration as either session cookies or persistent cookies. Session cookies expire when the User closes the browser. Persistent cookies expire once their purpose is fulfilled (e.g., keeping the User logged into the website's services) or when manually deleted.

- Registration Cookies: These are generated once the User has registered or logged in and are
  used to identify them in the Services for the following purposes.
- Analytical Cookies: Each time a User visits a Service, a tool from an external provider (specifically Google Analytics) generates an analytical cookie on the User's device. This cookie, created only during the visit, will be used in future visits to anonymously identify the visitor. The main objectives are:
